Each registration form can accommodate up to 10 quilts. (Contact information above).

Registration form must be completed in full and returned by July 1st. After July 1, 2017 we may be unable to accommodate changes to your registration form except to eliminate a quilt that is already registered. A quilt is registered when your completed registration form has been received with entry fee.

Once registration form is received and fee paid, “**show tags**” will be mailed and need to be attached to each of your quilts.

Quilts with “show tags” need to be received August 10th for display. “Show Tags” will remain on quilt while on display.

Quilts can be dropped off at Conconully Chamber of Commerce. Accepting date: August 10-15th. Also contact Janet at 509-826-2241 to make other arrangements.

Quilts will be ready for pick-up Saturday August 19th after the show.

Entry Criteria & Requirements

Entry fee \$10.00 up to 10 quilts as noted on registration form. Checks payable to “**Conconully C of C**”, P.O. Box 309, Conconully WA 98819.

Each exhibitor may enter a maximum of ten (10) quilts per registration form.

Each quilt must have name of quilter and name of quilt stitched on back for identification.

Each quilt must be two layers of fabric with a filling that is stitched together with lines or a pattern. Quilting may be done by hand or machine.

Each quilt must be at least 36”x36” and may not exceed 104” in length.

Not accepted: Quilts from other out of town groups as raffle items, shapes other than squares and rectangles, tablecloths, pillow shams or other non-quilted items.
